Ephesians 1:1-2

- 1.) Why is it important that Paul is writing Ephesians as someone who understands both what it means to be a sinner and what it means to be someone who has been saved by Jesus?
- 2.) Paul calls the Ephesians “saints” in verse 1. What does it mean that you are called one of God’s saint? Why is it significant that Paul begins his address to the Ephesians in this way?
- 3.) What are the implications of Paul’s identification of the Ephesians people as being citizens of both earth and heaven when he additionally refers to them as being “in Christ Jesus” in verse 1?
- 4.) Take the same quick tour of Ephesians that we took during today’s sermon looking at Eph. 2:12-19; 3:16-19; 5:1-2. What excites you about our study ahead in coming months?
