Express Grace: The Mission

Luke 19:1-10

- 1.) What does it mean to be “on mission”? Ray suggested there was a stark difference (often revealed in our prayers) between asking God to help us with our mission vs. being on his mission. What is that difference?
- 2.) Using this passage, can you summarize the mission of Jesus in one sentence?

HINT: See verse 10!
- 3.) What kind of people are the particular object of the mission of Jesus? How do you see that in this passage? What are other examples of things Jesus said or people Jesus encountered that reflect this mission?
- 4.) How would you describe the people with whom you spend a majority of your time? What does that reflect about the mission you are focused on?
- 5.) Ray said that the distinctiveness of Christianity is that “grace precedes repentance,” so people often “belong before they believe.” How have you experienced this reality? How should it change the way we engage – individually and corporately – with those who do not know Jesus?
- 6.) How did God challenge you through this message or the entire Express Grace Conference? What are you praying about in light of that?
