Resurrection Power from a Resurrected Savior  
January 25, 2015  
Ephesians 1:15-23

- 1.) How have you seen “faith in God” demonstrated in “love toward all the saints” among the people of God at Southwood?  
  
HINT: Stop and pray simply to thank God for these genuine manifestations of his Spirit living in and among us!
- 2.) Look back at the story of the church in Ephesus and the riot that took place in Acts 19. How would you have felt? Have you ever experienced similar emotions in your own life?
- 3.) Will mentioned things like the autonomous self and the almighty dollar as cultural idols of power. What else do you see our culture and/or our church looking to for power?
- 4.) When was the last time you felt fearful, timid, or insecure? How is the incomparable power of God a comfort or encouragement to you in that situation?
- 5.) When was the last time you felt strong and independent? What counterfeit sources of true power were you tempted to trust?  
  
HINT: Be more specific than simply “myself.” What about my money? The success of my political party? The influence of my online community? The impact of my unique experience?
- 6.) Where have you seen God’s power made perfect in man’s weakness (II Cor. 12:9)?
- 7.) What would it look like for you individually to “plug into” God’s power rather than relying on your own?
- 8.) What could it look like for us corporately to “plug into” God’s power rather than relying on our own? What could a church that is really dependent on God look like?
- 9.) How does it encourage, embolden, or excite you to know that the incomparable power of God is at work for the good of his church?
