- 1.) What words would you use to describe the Kingdom of God or “Church”? How far down the list is “party,” “feast,” or “celebration”? Why do you think that is?
- 2.) What is one “table” that you look to for significance? How would your life be different if your full significance came from being seated at God’s Table?
- 3.) What is the difference between the “social gospel” that is dangerously good and the true social gospel? (HINT: Consider what the good news actually is and who is responsible for it, among other differences.)
- 4.) How does thinking of the Kingdom of God as a feast change the way you approach the Lord’s Supper and what it looks like to celebrate that sacrament? How about the fact that it’s a “rehearsal dinner” for the eternal feast? Read Isaiah 25:6-9 together as you discuss.
- 5.) In what ways do you see the Church having some of the same struggles as the culture with being a transformed society that Jesus says we must be in his kingdom?
- 6.) Will said the gospel frees us to “throw parties like the one we’ve been invited to by God.” What would such a party look like? Don’t just talk about it! Plan such a party with your small group or your family. And when you throw that party, tell me about it and what God does in and through you so I can learn with you what this looks like!



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
