- 1.) Consider the life that you lived before you had a relationship with Christ. In what ways have you see your view of the world, your community and your understanding of God change since that time?
- 2.) Paul explains how intimate relationships are one of the major, life-giving components to being a member of the covenantal community. In what ways is that true of the relationships in your Southwood small group?
- 3.) In this passage Paul talks a lot about the peace that Christ made possible. What are some of the areas of your life and heart in which you need Christ to help make peace?
- 4.) What is the significance of God spanning that large chasm between being strangers to God and being fellow citizens in his household?
- 5.) Why do you think that Paul refers to Jesus as the cornerstone of the household of God? What made Jesus so important in this work of God making peace?
- 6.) Verse 22 concludes by calling the church, "the dwelling place for God." What are some of the implications of this for Southwood as a body of believers?



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
