- 4.) What things in life give you a deep sense of joy, and what does that show you about whom or what you truly worship/serve?

- 5.) What is one thing that money promises you that God offers you through himself? How does that warm your heart toward serving your true Master? (HINT: Read Hebrews 13:5-6, Philippians 4:12-19, or Psalm 23:1)
