Psalm 73

- 1.) Scotty said the Christian life and Christian churches should be places full of desperation and delight. What did he mean by that, and how do you see that reality in your own life?
  
- 2.) Consider a season in your life (past or present) when you were very aware of your envy of others and their success. What made that situation so difficult for you? How did you act on those feelings?
  
- 3.) Scotty said, "Comparison kills community." How have you seen that in your own heart and life, and how do you ever stop living in comparison?
  
- 4.) The psalmist in Psalm 73 is leading God's people in worship and confessing his own struggles. How does that make you feel about your own struggles? How does that impact your view/expectations of your pastors/leaders?
  
- 5.) Scotty spoke of God's grasp on us – that the Gospel of God's grace is the entire Christian life. How do you still find yourself in need of the gospel? In what ways do you feel you need to be beyond the gospel?
  
- 6.) What does it look like in your life when you believe that God is your portion and you desire nothing else in the world besides Him?
