2. In doing the work of proclaiming the Kingdom of Christ, too often our goal has been to gain conversions. How will our proclamation work be different if our goal is the worship of the nations rather than the conversion of the nations?
3. If we as Christians are called primarily to be worshippers of God and not adherents to a certain set of beliefs, how does that affect our concept of what it means to be Christian?
4. Why does God pour out His lavish blessings on us? What is His end goal?
5. If I were to see my life as a missionary right where I live now, how would life be different?
6. How does God bless us so lavishly? Does my life reflect that lavish blessing? How will I know if it does?
7. What needs to happen in you so that the joy of the Gospel will flow freely? What is keeping it from doing so now?
