- 2.) What are some forms of diversity that you see in our church? Where could we see more diversity in our church?
- 3.) Why is it important that Paul began his description of gifts with a reminder of Christ's ascension in verses 8-10?
- 4.) Paul does not give an exhaustive list of gifts here in chapter 4 of Ephesians. What are some of the other gifts the Bible talks about (see Romans 12:3-8)? What gifts do you see in yourself and your fellow small group members?
- 5.) How would you summarize the purpose of our gifts from verses 12-13? How should this change our perspective on the use of our gifts?
- 6.) What does it look like for you to use your gifts to the glory of God?
