- 3.) In what ways do you find yourself building your own name/reputation? Where do you feel like you struggle with seeking God's kingdom/agenda before your own?
- 4.) What would it look like in your mind if God's kingdom increasingly came in your own heart/in your own home/in your neighborhood/in your own city/in the world? Be specific.
- 5.) How does it encourage you to see Jesus sacrifice his own reputation, agenda, and will for the sake of the Father's? Where in your life do you think that sacrifice needs to happen?
- 6.) Have you ever felt called to vocational missions (especially in another country)? What has kept you here for now? Do you think God might call you to that in the future? Pray and encourage each other to consider that possibility!
