Daniel 7:9-10

- 1.) Will said we often treat heaven like an "I'll use it when I get there" topic. Do you find that to be true in your own life? Are you afraid of being heavenly minded and no earthly good?
- 2.) What biblical examples can you think of that refer to the present value of thinking of eternal realities?
- 3.) Read together Daniel 7:9-10 and Revelation 4:2-11. What are your immediate impressions/reactions to the visions reported to us? How are they supposed to make us feel?
- 4.) What particular detail of the vision of the Ancient of Days on his throne is most interesting or helpful to you?
- 5.) When was the last time you remember feeling overwhelmed, out of control, or helpless? Do you ever wake up and feel so small before a mountain of tasks or problems in your life? How would a clear vision of God on his throne speak into your heart in that moment?
- 6.) The realities of human history in these visions speak to significant suffering for God's people. How have you seen that be true, and how does the vision of God on his throne impact our suffering?
