Judges 3:12-30

1. Have you ever read through the book of Judges? If not, why? If you have, what has been your impression of the book? Is it difficult to relate to? Did the sermon on Ehud encourage you to read more in Judges?
2. When we are in hard circumstances, how does it help us to know that God's compassion for us never fails, even when He must bring His discipline into our lives? Refer also to Matt.7:11, Luke 11:13.
3. If God brings salvation to His people even before they are repentant, how will they be motivated to turn from our sin? If God waits until we are repentant, what will our salvation be based on? Will that encourage or discourage hope?
4. The main picture of Judges 3 is the utter foolishness of those who trust in idols, or things of their own making. How did Judges 3 bring out that utter foolishness? How are we like Israel back then, and even worse? How does our own idolatry demonstrate that same utter foolishness?
5. How is Christ pointed to in this story? How is He the greater Savior?
6. What is the primary thought or promise you can take away from Judges 3?
