- 5.) Where are you (or have you been) in a situation where it seemed impossible to have any hope or to trust God could be working to redeem? What helps you trust him against the circumstantial evidence?
- 6.) How does your heart engage with the Lord’s Supper in light of this story? How do you help your kids understand the significance of it in new and fresh ways?



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
