2 Corinthians 4: 1-16

1. Where in your life do you find your propensity to live out the prosperity gospel? How do we make the good news of the gospel into something material or temporal? How does this undercut the immensity of the Gospel?
2. What kinds of things bring about the greatest embarrassment to you? How do these reveal our sense of shame?
3. How would your life be different if you knew that you were truly beautiful? How is the message of the Gospel of Glory such good news for us?
4. Why does God insist on putting His glory in “jars of clay”?
5. How does that work contrary to our personal pursuits? How are we trying to produce our own glory?
6. In what ways have you had to suffer because of your belief in the Gospel? In what ways have you intentionally chosen to suffer because of the value of the Gospel?
7. Why is suffering necessary for us to display the glory of God? What does our joyful suffering say about the glory of God?
8. How does the Gospel give us reason to choose suffering and hardship over the pleasures of this world?
