 - b. If He is merely a ruler of a Kingdom, how will that affect the way we relate to Him?
 - c. If He is merely a moral example to follow, how will that affect us?
2. What are the ways that Jesus liberates us?
 - a. Imagine a world where the curse is no more. What do you look forward to the most?
 - b. Imagine a time when your own sin will bring no more shame or guilt? What are the ways life will be different?
3. How does Jesus' coming change the way we relate to God? How does it change the way we pray?
 - a. What are your prayers typically comprised of? What do you want from God?
 - b. What does this say about who you think God is?
 - c. If He was your deepest, most intimate love, how would that change the way you pray?
 - d. How can we get to that place where our prayers reflect our enjoyment of Him instead of what we want from Him?
