**Forgive One Another**  
**June 30, 2019**  
**Ephesians 4:25-32**

1. What aspect of God's forgiveness most amazes you? (Consider Ps. 103:12, Jer. 31:34, II Cor. 5:19, or Col. 1:13-14 if you need help)
2. What is your favorite story of human forgiveness (in your own life or not), and what most amazes you about it?
3. What makes forgiveness hard for you? Or what is your greatest fear in extending forgiveness?
4. Which one of the "weeds" from Ephesians 4:31 do you struggle with most? How does the gospel address that struggle?
5. Can you think of a relationship where you could plant "flowers" of restoration and forgiveness? Even if you can't name the person, what might steps in that process look like?
6. How should we pray for our church family as we seek to be a "community garden" marked by forgiveness?
