- 3.) Can you think of other examples in life besides soccer and this battle where one representative “fights” for the whole group?
- 4.) We typically think of ourselves as David in this story – having the courage to fight the giants in our lives or something to that effect. How is that not the best framework to understand this story, and on the other hand, what parts of that still appropriately apply to our lives?
- 5.) Have you noticed the tendency for Christians to “delegate” their zeal for God to someone else? What else besides our fearfulness, our addiction to self-serving comfort, and our celebrity culture do you think contributes to this dynamic?
- 6.) What is the biggest difference living as a champion and battling defeated foes (like sin, death, and the devil) makes in your life?
