Teach and Admonish One Another

Colossians 3:12-17

1. How do you think people would fill in the statement for you: "Everyone who knows me knows I love _____." How do you feel about that?
2. What do you most prefer to be defined by? What gives you significance or joy? How can anything that fits that role in our hearts become an idol?
3. What makes admonishing one another most difficult for you? Would it be harder for you to give or receive an admonition, and how does the gospel help you in that struggle?
4. Think of a person in your life that you consistently feel (or felt) pointed you to Jesus and encouraged you spiritually whenever you talked. What characterized them? Why was their relationship one you valued?
5. Does this mean that conversations with other Christians concerning, for example, football, food, movies, business, vacations, and shopping are now completely out of bounds? Then how does the priority of the gospel transform such conversations?
6. How can someone pray for you in regards to where you find your identity and delight?
