Psalm 19

- 3.) What is the connection between the first 6 verses of the psalm speaking about God’s general revelation in creation and the section beginning at verse 7 that speaks of God’s Word?
- 4.) What “part” of you (soul, mind, heart, eyes) most needs the help of God’s Word promised in verses 7-10?
- 5.) Where do you see some brown grass or negative emotions coming to the surface in your own life? How can you as a group help each other see what’s killing you underneath? Talk through going to the root of some struggles with anxiety, anger, fear, etc. together.
- 6.) How does the sacrifice of Jesus so that you can be declared innocent change your outlook on your life this week? Is it a theoretical truth that will matter when you die, or does it transform your present reality as well?



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
