1 Peter 4:7-10

2. When did you feel most welcome in someone else's home? What particular dynamics made you feel loved, welcomed, "at home" there?
3. How does knowing that "hospitality" comes from "stranger love" (loving guest or outsider) change your perspective on what God calls you to in this regard?
4. In what ways is having a hospitable heart (and life) harder for you than having a hospitable home (and resources)?
5. How does the gracious hospitality of God toward you make you feel? Why do you think you don't often feel joy about living this way toward others?
6. How can we pray for Southwood corporately and individually to be a hospitable Gospel community?
