God Is My Witness?

Micah 1:1-16

1. What is your initial reaction when you think of studying the Minor Prophets? How do you think they may be beneficial in your life individually or in our life corporately?
2. Do you always live with a vision of God that is as big and earth-shaking as Micah depicts Him? What things contribute to our sometimes small thoughts of God?
3. Do you think you ever minimize your sin in your own heart and mind because you attend church regularly, etc.? Why is that a dangerous possibility?
4. Have you ever considered your or our sin enough to be moved to tears? In what way is sorrow a significant part of your/our repentance?
5. In light of the holiness of God and his witnessing against us in our sin, how does the Lord's Supper become even more astonishing or taste even sweeter?
6. The manifestation of our wandering from God as his people today may look different in some ways from his people in Micah's day. How can we pray for one another and our pastors in light of that as we enter this study?
