- 1.) What are some reasons you've decided to be a part of a church (now or previously)? In what ways do some of these reflect a "consumer" approach to the mission of the Church rather than the mission laid out in the Bible? How does a church being "Christ-centered" push them towards the mission of I Peter 2:9-10, Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 1:8, or II Corinthians 5?

- 2.) What are some specific ways putting the glory and mission of Jesus at the center/hub of your life would impact the way you approach your free time? Your family life? Your relationships?

- 3.) Just over 10 years ago, Southwood's Senior Pastor, Mike Honeycutt, wrote, "We are not here primarily for ourselves; as a church in this community, we have got to realize that we are placed here by God for the sake of this community. Every follower of Christ follows Christ into the world for the sake of the world, and every congregation does the same. We should live in this community in such a way that this community would weep if we were to shut our doors— weep because they have been so blessed by us that they will miss us when we're gone."

For what reasons would Huntsville "weep" if Southwood and her people were gone tomorrow? What are some ways that you long to see the people and city of Huntsville reflect the Kingdom of God more than it does today? How could you be a part of that? In what ways would your dream require the community of God's people to labor in and pray for together?
