- 1.) What are some of the privileges of being an “American Christian” that you most enjoy?

- 2.) Alex suggested that those privileges become problematic when we begin to view them as things we are entitled to. What does that look like in your life? How would we know if something we enjoy is something we are feeling entitled to?

- 3.) Alex said that the sea “broke” Jonah so that he finally cried out to God. What evidence do you see of that in the first two chapters of Jonah? What evidence do you have from your own life that difficult circumstances often lead to broken people who cry out to God?

- 4.) What is the calling God has given to the Church in our day? What does it mean for the Church to be a “prophetic witness”?

- 5.) What do you think it could look like for Southwood to have an increasingly “prophetic witness” in the city of Huntsville? Where are we already engaged? Where are we missing opportunities individually and corporately?

- 6.) Pray together for God to give us his heart for the nations and our community in particular. What was the result of Jonah’s brokenness after God rescued him? What did he do in the rest of the book?
