Signs of the Times
September 17, 2017
Luke 11:14-36

1. The immediate problem that Jesus addressed was that the people were demanding a “sign” from Him. Why was that such a bad thing? How do we fall into that same trap and demand proof from God before we will trust Him?
2. In the sermon we learned that unbelief was **intentional**. How does knowing that change the way we speak to non-Christians about Jesus? How does that affect the way we encourage Christians to greater faith?
3. In the sermon we also learned that unbelief was **irrational**. How does knowing this help us to relate to non-believers? How does this affect our own struggle with unbelief?
4. Finally, from the sermon we learned that unbelief was **short-sighted**, which basically says that we choose alternatives in which to place our trust and find our value other than our Creator. How can we use this concept to better evangelize our non-Christian friends? What alternatives to we run to for value and life?
5. How is the death and resurrection of Jesus the ultimate antidote to unbelief? How does it declare the glorious rule of King Jesus? How does it demonstrate God’s heart for sinners?
