- 2.) Mark made the point that the origin of the river in Ezekiel 47 was NOT the palace, the university, or the sports arena (among many other places). How does this run counter to the assumptions of our culture?
- 3.) Mark asked, “What’s on the altar of your heart?” How would you answer that, and how would you know?
- 4.) How have you experienced the reality that grace grows as it is shared rather than running out?
- 5.) Mark challenged us to leave as “rivers of grace.” What do you think that might look like in your office? In your neighborhood? In your kids’ school? Somewhere else?
- 6.) If the Church is God’s “change agent for the world,” how should that change the way we engage with it? How do we often engage, and what do we usually expect from Church?
