Luke 4:14-30

- 1.) What does it mean for a church to be “Christ-centered”? What does it look like for a church to be “Christ-centered”?
- 2.) Most of us are more comfortable EITHER talking about the love of Jesus OR demonstrating the love of Jesus. Which one is harder for you, and why?
- 3.) Read Leviticus 25:8-17. What is the “jubilee” idea behind what Jesus is reading about in Isaiah 61? What happens in “the year of the Lord’s favor”? What does that look like in Jesus’ life and ministry?
- 4.) How do you see your own struggle with Jesus’ commitment to run graciously after outsiders? What does a struggle with comparison, consumerism, or community dynamics look like in your heart?
- 5.) Can you think of a person or a group of people who ought to be “in” at Southwood as the priorities of Jesus’ kingdom increasingly impact our ministry? Now answer the same question for your own life!
- 6.) In what ways do you “get rid of Jesus” or keep him and his priorities at arms’ length? In what ways do we corporately do the same thing?
- 7.) Will described Jesus’ kingdom in terms of its inclusive exclusivism. What in the world did he mean? How should that impact our lives and our church?
