Romans 15:23-33

- 1.) Share a time recently when you made plans only to find them changed. Are you living in a season right now that you would never have planned for?
- 2.) Justin said, "Our plans don't have to work out because His do." How have you found that to be true in your life? Where have you experienced God's plans being better for you than your own?
- 3.) How did hearing Justin's stories from his past couple years in Africa challenge you in your involvement with the advance of the gospel around the world? If we are called, as Paul challenged the Romans, to share in the joy of the gospel advancing, what could that look like for you?
- 4.) What does it mean to "strive in prayer," and how is that different from merely praying occasionally? Are you striving in prayer for yourself or for the kingdom of God?
- 5.) What will you do in the next few weeks to have your vision of the worldwide advance of the gospel expanded? How does your heart need to be encouraged/challenged?
- 6.) Who is laboring for the gospel around the world who may be lacking the community Justin shared as being so valuable? How can you encourage them?
