Colossians 3:1-4

1. In v.1 the word “If” appears at the beginning of some translations. It’s not a “what if” but rather a declaration of and accomplished reality. The verb actually means to be “co-resurrected.” How does this provide encouragement to our daily lives?

3. In your own words, what does it mean to “set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth?”
4. What are some of the things that keep your mind from focusing on the things that are above?
5. According to verse 3 and 4, what are the realities promised to those are in Christ?
6. What does Paul mean when he writes, “For you have died...?”
7. What does Paul mean when he writes, “...you will also appear with him in glory?”
8. How can our future reality in Christ affect and impact our current life, identity, belonging, and purpose?
