The Sacrifice of the Incarnation

December 10, 2017

Philippians 2:3-8

- 1.) What sorts of things do you hold onto due to sentimentality or practicality? What are immaterial things (time, relationships, concepts, etc.) you tend to cling to tightly and refuse to sacrifice?
  
- 2.) Consider again what Jesus sacrificed in order to become flesh and be born as a baby. Which part of that sacrifice is the most amazing to you?
  
- 3.) Discuss how the Incarnation of Jesus can appropriately be an example to us AND what is lost if it is only or primarily an example.
  
- 4.) What is one way you feel Jesus calling you out of your comfort zone for the sake of others? What is one thing you tend to cling to that you feel Jesus calling you to sacrifice for the sake of someone else? What will “considering others more significant than ourselves” look like for you? ... for us?
  
- 5.) How does it encourage you that Jesus empowers us for those things to which he calls us?
