Colossians 3:22-4:1

1. What would you say to a neighbor who says the Bible's teaching on slavery demonstrates how irrelevant the Scriptures are in today's world?
2. Have you ever struggled with frustration, insignificance, or lack of appreciation for what you do on a daily basis (paid or not!)? How does Colossians 3:23 and the supremacy of Jesus give hope to your labors?
3. What is the Bible's purpose for power? How do we often misuse it or have it misused against us?
4. Describe someone different from you with whom it's hard for you to relate. What does the Gospel call us and empower us to toward such people?
5. How does the incarnation and death of Jesus give us an example AND empower us for countercultural living in these areas? BONUS: Who is the ultimate hero when you cross socioeconomic lines to love someone sacrificially?
6. Does preaching that highlights social implications of the Gospel make you uncomfortable? How do we maintain the good news of Savior clarity without sacrificing real social change Jesus calls us to?
