Colossians 1:15-20

1. Why do you think issues about the person of Jesus (his divinity, humanity, character, etc.) are so vital for Christians to be clear on?
2. What analogy communicates well (if imperfectly) to you what it means for Jesus to be the image of God, the radiance of his glory, the exact imprint of his nature?
3. When was the last time contemplating the glory of Jesus and/or what He has done for you spontaneously produced praise in your heart, singing on your lips, or poetry from your pen?
4. A Jehovah's Witness at your front door or another friend of yours says, "Jesus was a great guy, sure, but c'mon, he wasn't God." How would you respond? How eager are you to have conversations like these about things of eternal importance?
5. What is something in your life currently that feels like it might fall apart? How can you pray in light of Jesus being the one who holds all things together?
6. What situation from the life of Jesus most helps you know God's heart to you in a place of struggle, sin, or sadness in your life?

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
