

# SMALL GROUP Q'S

The Next Generation

Psalm 145

1.) Do you think of yourself as part of the “next generation” or as looking back to the “next generation”? How has that self-perception changed in the past few years?

2.) When David considers who God is and what God has done for him, what is the result in his heart that is evident in this psalm? How have you experienced that in your own life?

3.) What is the biblical pattern for the extension of God’s kingdom evident in Psalm 145 (especially vv4-7)? Where else in the Bible do we see this pattern?

HINT: God works to extend his kingdom through one generation after another passing along his greatness and his great deeds. One generation makes much of God and passes to the next generation an exalted view of God (Psalms, Exodus and the feasts of Israel, Jesus and children, etc. are great examples).

4.) What does Student Ministry mean at Southwood? What has been your previous experience with Student Ministry? What could be your future engagement with Student Ministry?

5.) If you asked your children or your close friends what is most important to you, what you make much of in your life, what do you think they would say? In what ways do you as a parent/adult need to be grabbing your own oxygen mask first and breathing deeply of Jesus?

6.) In what ways can your small group make an impact on the next generation of the church in Huntsville?
