Ephesians 2:1-10

- 1.) Chapter 2 of Ephesians begins to focus on the state of man and God's grace towards us in our sin. Why is it important that we first understand our sin before we understand God's grace?
- 2.) Before you knew Christ what were some ways that your heart followed "the course of this world" and "the prince of the power of the air?"
- 3.) Why is it often so difficult for us to plumb the depths of our depravity as Paul describes it in verses 1-3?
- 4.) In what ways is Paul's insertion of God's mercy in the "But God..." statement of verse 4 an encouragement to you?
- 5.) Verses 4-9 give one of the Bible's most classic presentations of God's grace. Reread these verses and talk about what parts of Paul's articulation of grace are meaningful to you?
- 6.) Looking ahead to next week's sermon, discuss how Ephesians 2:1-9 sets us up for the importance of verse 10.
