Impressing Jesus
February 26, 2017
Luke 7: 1-10

1. If someone who was in great need came to you asking for help (such as finances, food, etc.), what would you need to see in them to determine that they deserved your help? What behaviors would disqualify them?
2. When you are coming before God, what are those qualities that you look for to make yourself worthy? (Maybe something like being faithful with spiritual disciplines, refraining from certain sins, etc.)
3. What qualities would make you very unworthy? What can you do to be excluded from God's blessing? What quality about you makes you hesitate to come to the Father freely asking for His help and provision for something you desperately want?
4. How does the Gospel turn this approach on its head? How worthy does Jesus make us?
5. Who are the ones to whom you have given authority to speak truth into your life? What do they say? Is it good or bad?
6. What do you typically say about you?
7. What has Jesus accomplished for you and declared about you? What does the Gospel now say is true of you?
8. What do we have trouble listening to Him and instead listen to others who so readily condemn?
9. If we truly believed the promises Jesus makes and who He has declared us to be, how would life be different?
