 - c. Our view of our salvation?
2. How has Jesus been disrupting your plans for life, identity, and significance? What has been your response to His disruptions? What might He be calling you to instead?
3. How has Jesus been exposing more of your sinful heart? What circumstances or people is He using to enable you to see more clearly your need for a real Savior? What has been your response to this exposure?
4. Why do we have such a difficult time believing that we are indeed loved by God such that He, the Son of Man, would be condemned in place of us?
5. What do we have to believe about ourselves and about Him in order to more fully comprehend that love?
