- 1.) Paul speaks in this passage about the purpose and plan for the church. Before your read and studied this passage, how would you have described the reason that the church exists?
- 2.) What are the implications of Paul calling himself “the least of all the saints” - why is it important that he refers to himself in this way?
- 3.) What would it look like for you to live your life as “the least of all the saints?” How does believing this affect your heart toward God and your attitude toward others?
- 4.) We are told in verse 10 that God intends to use the church to display the manifold wisdom of God. How does this inform your perspective on the people, places and things that we should be engaging as God’s people?
- 5.) Look again at Ephesians 3:11-13. Describe and discuss the relationship between suffering and glory in the life of a believer?
