

# SERMON Q's

**The Dying Savior**  
**April 14, 2019**  
**Luke 23:44-56**

1. How does the death of Jesus on the cross highlight the perhaps uncomfortable nature of our sin and God's just judgment? What emotions do you have when you contemplate the reality that Jesus really died?
2. What are ways you seek to make your "eggshell" safe from God's wrath or on God's good side other than fleeing for refuge to Jesus?
3. Is death something you think about a lot? What is one thing about the way Jesus died that you hope characterizes you at your death?
4. Do you think the look on your face and the spirit in your heart when you come into God's presence mirrors Lily's when she runs into my office? Why or why not? How does contemplating the cross warm your heart with God's love?
5. Read Hebrews 10:19-23 together. What would it look like practically in your life to "draw near to God" and "hold fast to your confession" as the cross of Jesus empowers us to do?
6. Who are you particularly praying for the message of Christ to impact this Easter, and how could someone pray for your heart as you contemplate a dying and rising Savior?
