Luke 17:1-10

- 1.) Jesus has strong words of warning for those who would lead little ones toward sin and away from him. What part of your own life does his warning make you consider? Where have you seen and/or benefitted from someone who caused a "little one" to stand firm/be anchored in Jesus?
  
- 2.) What tends to be harder for you: Jesus' command to rebuke others' sin OR Jesus' command to forgive others' sin? Why do you think it is such a struggle for you?
  
- 3.) Why did Will say Jesus is essential to enabling the kind of community He commands us to live in? When was the last time you personally felt the tidal wave of God's grace that enables you to have rivers of grace for others? Who needs to experience that forgiveness from you?
  
- 4.) How do you sometimes feel about your obedience to Jesus? Is he impressed? Are you sometimes impressed with yourself and forget that you lived by the strength of the Holy Spirit? What does it practically look like to depend upon the grace of the Holy Spirit each day?
