- 2.) In what ways do you feel the “not yet” nature of the kingdom most acutely? Where do Jesus’ words point you for hope, and how can you cling to that?

- 3.) Who comes to mind for you when you think about two people together who end up in different eternal destinations? What will it look like for you to pray persistently and/or love intentionally in their life?

- 4.) When you are not thinking of a person as an eternal soul, how are you likely to think of them: means to an end for you, frustration to you, serving your immediate needs? How can we train our hearts to view others differently?

- 5.) How do we love people intentionally without creating an “Us vs. Them” mentality where we feel and act superior?

- 6.) How does Jesus’ finished work give you hope for evangelism and the eternal state of those you love?
