- 4.) How does it help us in our difficulties to know that God tells us to expect them as his people? Do you wish He didn't tell us the suffering was coming? To use the rollercoaster analogy, how does this help us brace our hearts? And why do we usually seek to avoid the turn or the drop instead of bracing for it?
- 5.) What is the most glorious part of this vision of heaven for you? Finish this sentence in the most glorious way to your heart: "A day is coming when you will \_\_\_\_\_"?
- 6.) We have spent three weeks looking at visions of heaven in Daniel. Do you think about heaven enough? What is the most encouraging aspect of considering eternal realities for you?
- 7.) Will described Jesus as a companion on the path who has already been to the top and insists we join him in his glory. Do you see him that way? What does it do to your outlook on life to know him like that?



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
