3. What is “gospel-centered” community and how does “bearing one another’s burdens” relate to it?
4. What does Paul mean when he writes, “fulfill the Law of Christ?”
5. What are some of the ways that our sinful pride keeps us from casting our burdens upon Christ and others in our life?
6. In regards to your schedule, what’s the largest time obstacle keeping you from carving out the time necessary to build gospel-centered relationships with others in the name of Christ?
