- 1.) Can you think of something good in your life that wasn't fully enjoyed until you shared it with someone you love?

- 2.) How does the physical situation of God's people, and the lepers in particular, mirror our spiritual desperation? Why in being motivated to "evangelize" is it so important to recognize our need for Jesus?

- 3.) What are some of the primary reasons you don't share the good news in situations where you could? How should the good news itself (the love of Jesus) transform our hearts in those areas? BONUS: Why is it safe to repent of loving things like comfort and control more than we love our neighbors?

- 4.) What is one thing/product/position (besides Jesus) that you are an "evangelist" for? Why are you so passionate about that, and what makes the good news of Jesus harder to share about?

- 5.) Pick at least one friend/acquaintance/family member whose name you can share with the group that you would like to pray for – for God's work in their heart and for boldness to share the good news with them yourself?

- 6.) Spend a few minutes together recounting how God has "opened the windows of heaven" and dumped grace into your lives. What does recalling these overwhelming, undeserved gifts do to your heart?
