Matthew 16:13-23

1. What is one takeaway for you personally from the Summer of One Another? What is one practical step you intend to take in light of God's design for us as a Gospel Community?
2. What can be the danger in your own heart of becoming comfortable with one another? Why is it so tempting to focus only on one another?
3. How have you seen the Parable of the Life-Saving Station play out in your own personal or church life? Where do we need to repent?
4. What do you think most keeps you from realizing the reality of our enemy and the urgency of the battle Jesus says we are in?
5. How does the certainty of our victory encourage/inspire you to be a part of a "raid on Hell" in a way that might seem dangerous, uncomfortable, or beyond you?
6. Will told the story of the church in Glasgow, Scotland sharing Jesus with Muslim refugee neighbors. How can we be praying for Southwood as a church to pursue the mission of Christ in Huntsville?
