- 4.) Give an example from your own life of where Satan used your sin or failure to tempt you to doubt God's love for you or your relationship with him. In what area are you most tempted to try to stand on your own as a "good _____" rather than standing in Christ as God's son/daughter?

- 5.) Will used the image of a wobbly toddler holding onto the strong hand of his father as he learns to walk. How does this image of your Father, whose love will never let you go, comfort you and encourage you in your prayers?
