An Often Forgotten Promise

Acts 1:1-11

1. Would you describe yourself as a conceptual Trinitarian or a functional Trinitarian? Why? What evidence is there in your life that would determine that?
  
2. Why are we so addicted to our own resources and abilities, even after they have failed us to often?
  
3. Do you have trouble seeing yourself as “empowered”? Why? If you believed you were indeed empowered by the Spirit, what would you expect to see in your life?
  
4. How does our empowering by the Spirit enable us to go to the nations?
  - a. How does it speak to our fears of harm or hardship?
  - b. How does it speak to our fears of failure?
  - c. How does it speak to our struggle to lay aside our predictable lives for uncertainty?
  - d. What are the other challenges it speaks to?
  
5. In your own experience, what is the most difficult thing for you to believe about the Gospel or the presence of the Spirit? How can we help one another towards a stronger faith?
