Colossians 3:12-14

1. How would you explain to someone who is not a Christian how Christianity is different from “religion”? How is it more than “do’s” and “don’t’s”?
2. Do you have a hard time believing what God says about you - that you are chosen, holy, and beloved by Him? How does forgetting that make being others-focused hard?
3. Share an example of a time someone in your church family demonstrated kindness, humility, or forgiveness to you.
4. What type of person do find it hardest to be patient with, compassionate toward, or forgiving of? Why do you think that is, and how can we pray for God to work in your heart in that area?
5. If love is what holds all these virtues together in harmony, how do we make sure we’re dealing with our hearts rather than mere external conformity?
6. What is one way you practically put on Jesus’ clothes so that your life is different but not in your own goodness?
