3. How does it encourage your prayers to consider that God answers even better than what we ask? How have you experienced that in your own life?
4. In what ways are you trying to write your own story with your own hopes rather than finding your hope in being swept up into God’s great story?
5. What does ordinary faithfulness look like for you this week? How might God use it beyond what you are anticipating as you consider his story and his priorities?
6. How does God’s presence in your life open your heart to expecting extraordinary things even on ordinary days?
