I John 4:7-19

- 1.) Can you think of a moment when you first remember experiencing the love of a parent for a child (whether you were the child or the parent at the time)?
- 2.) How does the Father's willingness to send his Son remind us of the significance of his love for us?
- 3.) Where in this passage (different places) do we see all three members of the Trinity involved in showing the love of God to us?
- 4.) Hunter said, "When we realize how great God's love is, our hearts will break." What did he mean by this?

HINT: Recall the concept of our hearts breaking because of overflowing with God's love to express to others.
- 5.) What does I John 4 say should be our response to the love of God? What is a particular opportunity you have to mirror the way God has loved you toward a family member, neighbor, or enemy?
- 6.) At Christmas we particularly celebrate the love of God that moved toward us when we were undeserving. Who needs you to show them that kind of love this Christmas season?
