The Cost of Christmas

Philippians 2:5-11

1. When we think about Jesus at Christmas, do we typically consider his being fully God or fully man more often? How does remembering both realities enrich the glory of Christmas?

2. What aspect of the sacrifice Jesus made in becoming man and living and dying for us is most amazing to you?

3. How costly would it be to you to give up rights, comforts, and relationships? How does that thought increase the weight of the incarnation for you?

4. Do you struggle to believe Jesus values you enough to pay the high cost because of his love for you? How can others remind you of that great truth?

5. What could it look like if we “have this mind among ourselves which is ours in Christ Jesus” and willingly pay great cost to demonstrate great love?

6. How does the cost Jesus paid to come for you impact your heart - your love for and worship of Him?
