3. What do you think of when you consider that you are at peace with God in your relationship? Is that a neutral status or an incomprehensibly positive place?
4. Do others in your life have a sense of the enormity of Christmas in bringing peace between man and God? How can you help your kids or your neighbors come to grips with this amazing reality?
5. Can you imagine being in the position of contemplating your own child as a “tarop tim,” peace child? How does contemplating this enlarge your perspective on God’s love for you in giving his only Son?
6. In what present life situation can others pray for you to have Christmas break down your cynicism and embrace trusting the God who is the Prince of Peace?

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
